Summary:

- CD-17 spans over three counties of NYS Westchester, Rockland and Putnam Counties.
 - These communities are a mix of metro and rural areas with essential healthcare providers spread throughout the region.
 - Rockland County specifically has one of the highest percentages of the population covered under Medicaid (35% overall) with one of the highest percentages of children covered (46%) statewide.
- The \$4.8B of Medicaid funding in the CD supports nearly 400 Medicaid providers including essential hospitals and nursing homes.
 - There are 15 Hospitals that receive over \$1 billion through various Medicaid funding streams and employ over 23,000 New Yorkers.
 - Total Annual Medicaid Payments =\$1.2B
 - Medicaid Patient Revenue (2023) = \$878M
 - State Directed Payment Revenue = \$100M
 - State Only Subsidy = \$70M
 - 1115 Incentive Funding = \$150M
 - There are 51 Nursing Homes in the CD that receive over \$552M annually in Medicaid funding and employ over 8,356 New Yorkers.
