Schumer Report: Violent Crime Up 10% in Upstate NY, Drug Arrests Increase 20% As Worries of Gang Violence Spread In Cities and Communities

With concerns over the growing gang presence across upstate New York and an increase in school violence in the United States, U.S. Senator Charles E. Schumer today released a new report showing that there has been a 10 percent increase in reports of violent crime and a nearly 20 percent jump in the number of drug arrests in cities and communities across upstate New York.

Upstate New York has seen an increase in violent crime and drug-related offenses across the board. In 2005, 25,113 violent crimes were reported according to the New York State Department of Criminal Justice Services. This represents an increase of nearly 10 percent from 23,310 reported in 2000. Schumer said that there has also been an even greater increase in the number of felony and misdemeanor drug arrests. In 2000, 19,113 arrests were made for drug related crimes (both felony and misdemeanor). That number rose to 22,449 arrests in 2005, a 17.5 percent increase. Arrests for violent crime were also up to 13,812 in 2005, up from 13,422 in 2000.

In the Capital Region, there were 3,443 violent reported crimes in 2005 and 2,846 drug arrests.
